COOPERATIVE COMMUNITY PRINCIPLE HELPS SIOUX COUNTY

Sioux County Rescue recently received a \$5000.00 check accompanied by a letter from Basin Electric, stating "As a cooperative, our hearts also lie with supporting the communities, such as yours, where our members work, live, and serve. These communities have supported us throughout the years by providing a strong work force, essential services, and a sense of pride. In that cooperative spirit, I'm happy to inform you that your organization has been selected to receive a donation from Basin Electric Power Cooperative as a member match with Niobrara Electric Association."

According to Leslie Bannan, Sioux County Rescue recently purchased a second ambulance through grants and donations from the state, the federal government, community members, local businesses, and other supporters. Their sole ambulance has been a type 1 ambulance since their other type 1 ambulance had major unrepairable mechanical problems almost two years ago. Donations received over the past year allowed Sioux County Rescue to purchase a type 2 ambulance plus the supplies and equipment to stock it so it could be put into service. "Doing a large-scale project such as this takes time, there is paperwork and state guidelines to follow to ensure everything is up to regulation. Each donation for this project and every donation to Sioux County Rescue in general are very important in keeping the volunteer EMS service available in the community. The power cot and new equipment are a true asset to the patients and the ambulance crew when working in such rural areas."

Sioux County Rescue transports their patients to Chadron Community Hospital and Regional West Medical Center in Scottsbluff. This decision is based on level of care needed or patient preference, both hospitals are relatively close in terms of transport time. Sioux County Rescue also utilizes Black Hills Life Flight out of Hot Springs South Dakota and Air Link out of Scottsbluff Nebraska if ALS care is needed. Having both of these helicopter flight crews so close is a game changer when minutes matter and treating patients in such rural areas.
